A fully integrated global organisation, GS1 was formed in early 2005 from the joining of EAN International and the Uniform Code Council (UCC).

- More than 30 years of experience
- 108 local GS1 organisations representing all points in the supply chain
- Over 1700 professionals around the world
- Over a million companies doing business across 145 countries
- Over 20 represented sectors (FMCG, healthcare, transport, defence...)
- Over 5 billion transactions a day

- GDSN: Global Data Synchronisation Network
- An automated, standards-based global environment that enables secure and continuous data synchronisation, allowing all partners to have consistent item data in their systems at the same time




#### Global standards for RFID-based identification


More accurate, immediate & cost-effective visibility of information



- A global standard system that combines radio frequency identification (RFID) technology, existing communications network infrastructure and the Electronic Product Code (a number for uniquely identifying an item)
- Immediate and automatic identification and tracking of an item through the whole supply chain
- Improved efficiency and visibility in the supply chain






#### **Our Organisation**
